Barbecue Safety

Grease Fires

Avoid nasty surprises with a quick and easy 30-minute maintenance schedule, twice a season.

Did you know?

- Lack of proper maintenance can cause BBQ [grease fires](#) and will affect your BBQ's performance and durability.
- Small insects are attracted to the smell of gas and will frequently enter your BBQ's burner Venturi tubes? They cause dangerous obstructions that result in [flash fires](#) causing damage to your BBQ and possible injury to you or your family. Keep your burners clean!



Leak Test

Check it yourself. Protect your family from dangerous fires and/or explosions.

Perform a [Leak Test](#) each and every time you change your gas tank, when your gas appliance has not been used for a period of time, or if you notice a dramatic change in your appliances performance.

- All you need is a 50/50 soap and water solution, and, either a spray bottle or a paint brush. Application is simple: either spray or brush the solution on all connections including the hose and gas source connection, and look for bubbles.
- A leak test is the ONLY way you will KNOW that your appliance is operating safely. If a leak is detected, IMMEDIATELY shut OFF the gas supply, tighten all connections ensuring they are all properly positioned and not cross threaded.
